

Symposium Internship Program

Through our partnership with The Dupzyk Ranch foundation, in 2023 we are able to expand our symposium internship program. In order to get RTN ready, keep our wheels rolling, the stock tended, and the trial/test scores recorded – we need helpers! Your brawn will help pay your class tuition!! For each 10 hours of help you give, you will receive 1 day tuition credit.

Before June 29th – we need help with landscaping, painting, minor fence repair, house cleaning (the office trailer) etc. If you have time between now and then – WE WANT YOU!

June 30th to July 9 – we need help with stock handling, scribes, timers, sheet runners during the trials and test, setting up canopies and water stations, helping with lunch service, taking down canopies at end of day, feeding livestock, feeding/watering kennel dogs, hauling water for the livestock, trash duty, etc.

Minimum requirements:

- 1. Interns must commit to 10 hours of service June 30th July 9^{th.}
- 2. All interns must participate in the hands-on practicum on Wednesday morning to help with vaccination, worming, banding, micro-chipping, and record keeping of the goat kids.
- 3. Tuition is earned 1 day at a time no partial days, no splitting days. If you provide 10 hours of service during June and the 10 hours during the symposium, you will receive 2 days of tuition credit for symposium. If you provide 20 hours in June and the 10 during the symposium, you will receive 3 days of tuition credit. 30 hours + 10 hours receives 4 days of tuition credit. 40 hours in June and the 10 during the symposium means a full ride all 5 days, all classes.
- 4. While you can work multiple dogs during the day only 1 dog per class. You can only use intern credit for 1 class per session.
